Question from Industry:

The Objective 4 from DO-330/ED-215 Annex A <u>Table T-0</u> is:

"Tool Operational Requirements are complete, accurate, verifiable, and consistent."

But when considering the associated activities in Paragraph 6.2.2, item a, verifiability is not mentioned. When an applicant is applying DO-330/ED-215, should "verifiability" be considered for this objective?

Response from FAS:

Yes. An objective should be fully achieved. It is the opinion of FAS that the criteria "verifiability" should be considered when performing the activity described in DO-330/ED-215 Paragraph 6.2.2, item a.
